


The Danish Institute of Arbitration's caseload


In the past four years, the Danish Institute of Arbitration (DIA) has filed an average of 112 cases.



As a dispute can, for example, refer to a Purchase agreement in the IT sector or an IT agreement in the Energy sector, the two statistics are separated as follows:





Nationality of the parties

The parties in the cases filed in 2014 came from 17 different nationalities: from the Americas (USA, Canada and Brazil), from Africa (Morocco and Kenya), from Asia (Singapore), from Central Europe (France, Spain, Luxembourg, Germany among others) and of course from Scandinavia.

The Arbitration cases

Of the Arbitral Tribunals appointed in 2014, 58% were composed of a Sole Arbitrator and 42% were a three-member Arbitral Tribunal.
