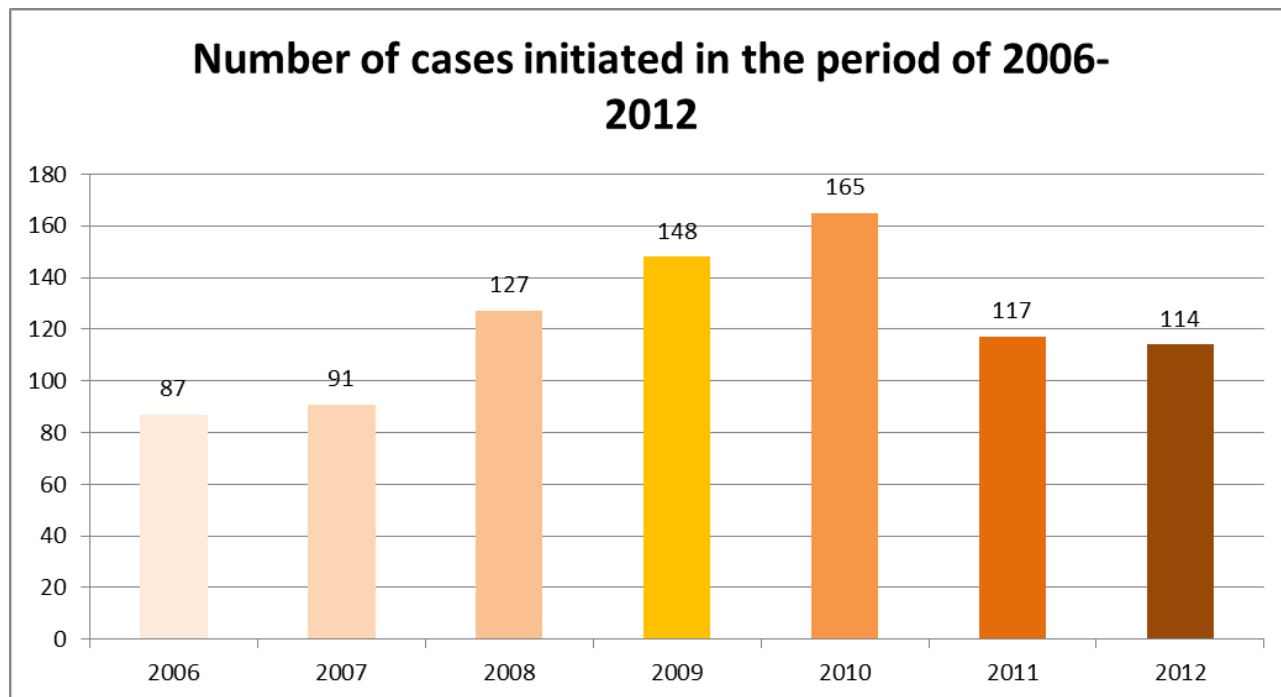
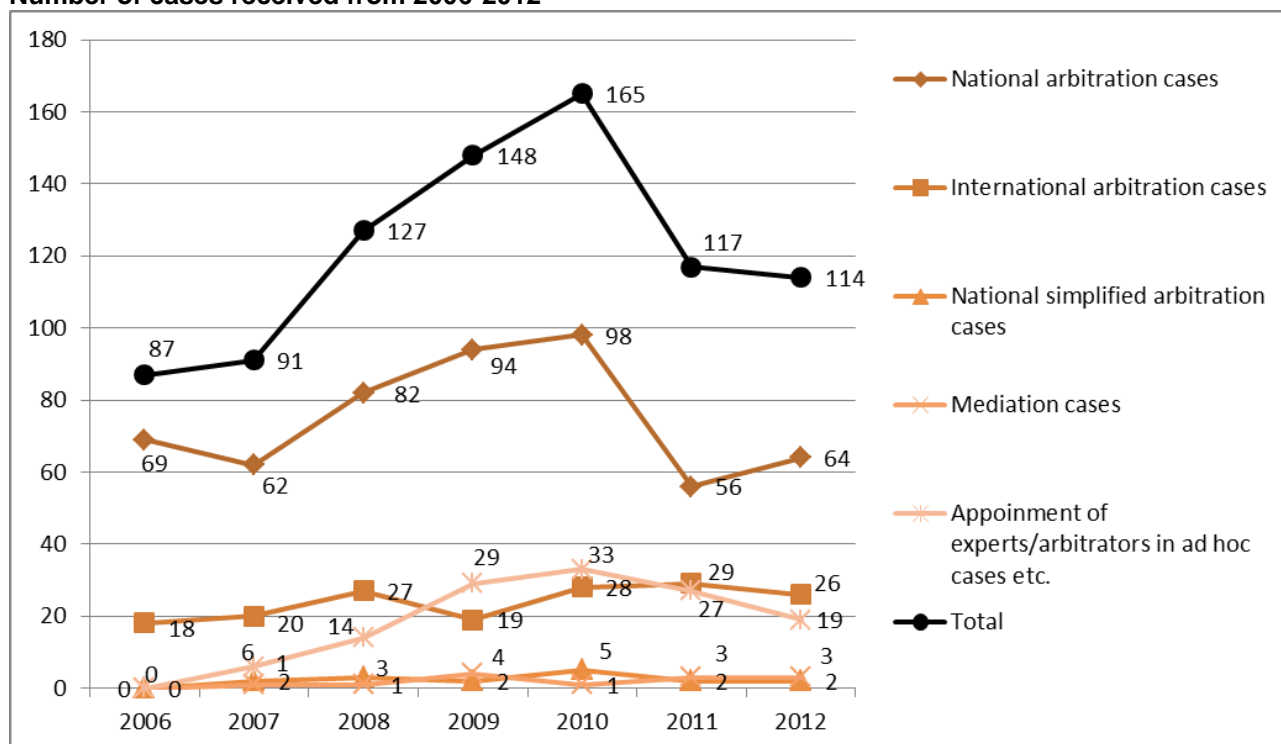


## Statistics 2012

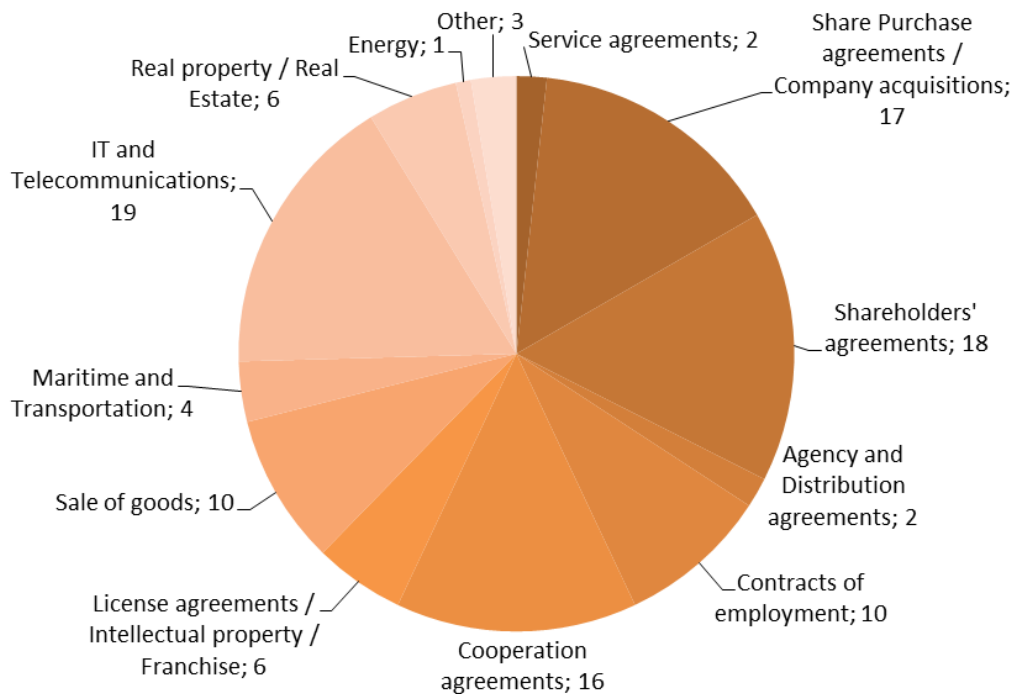

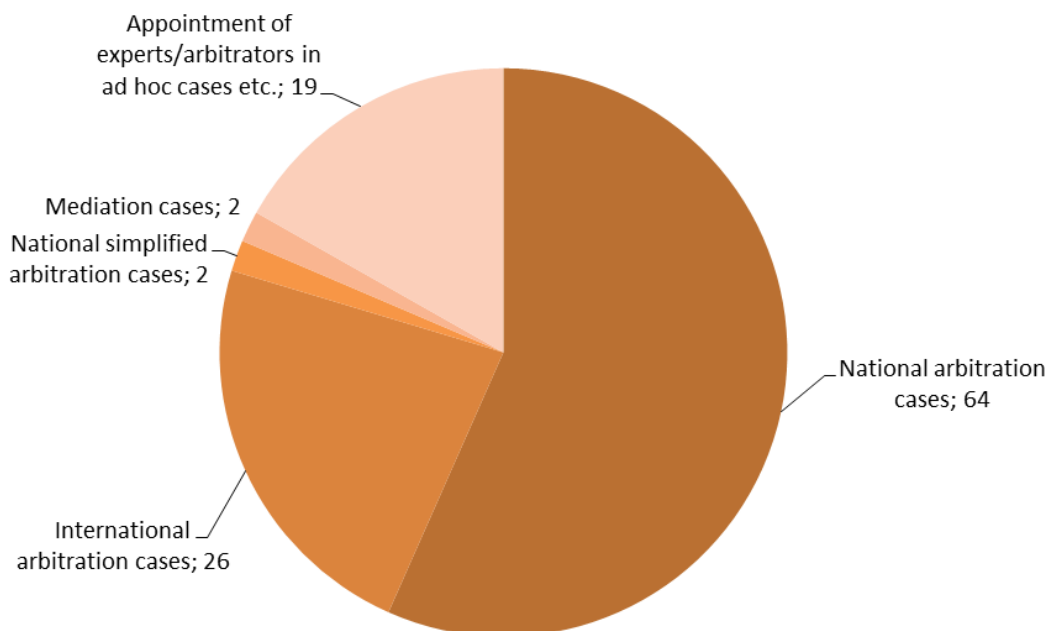
### Number of cases received from 2006-2012



### Cases received in 2012 - divided by subject

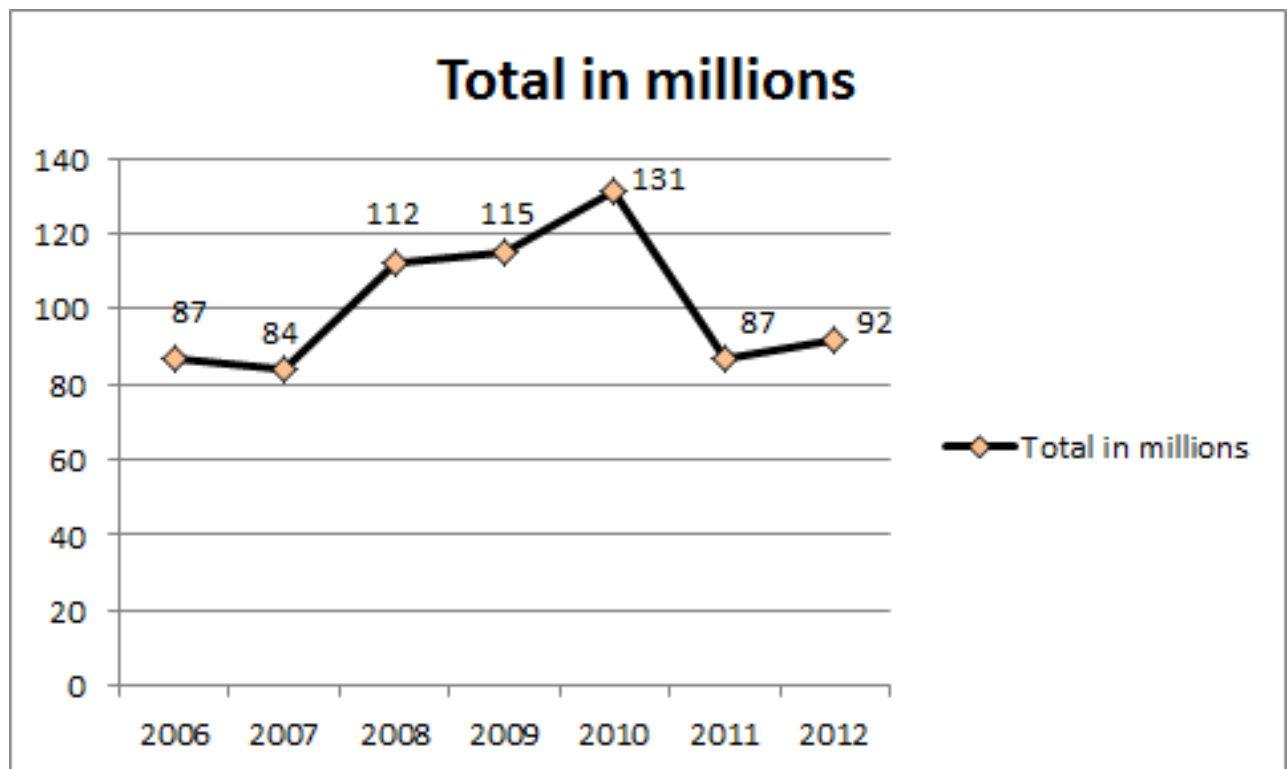
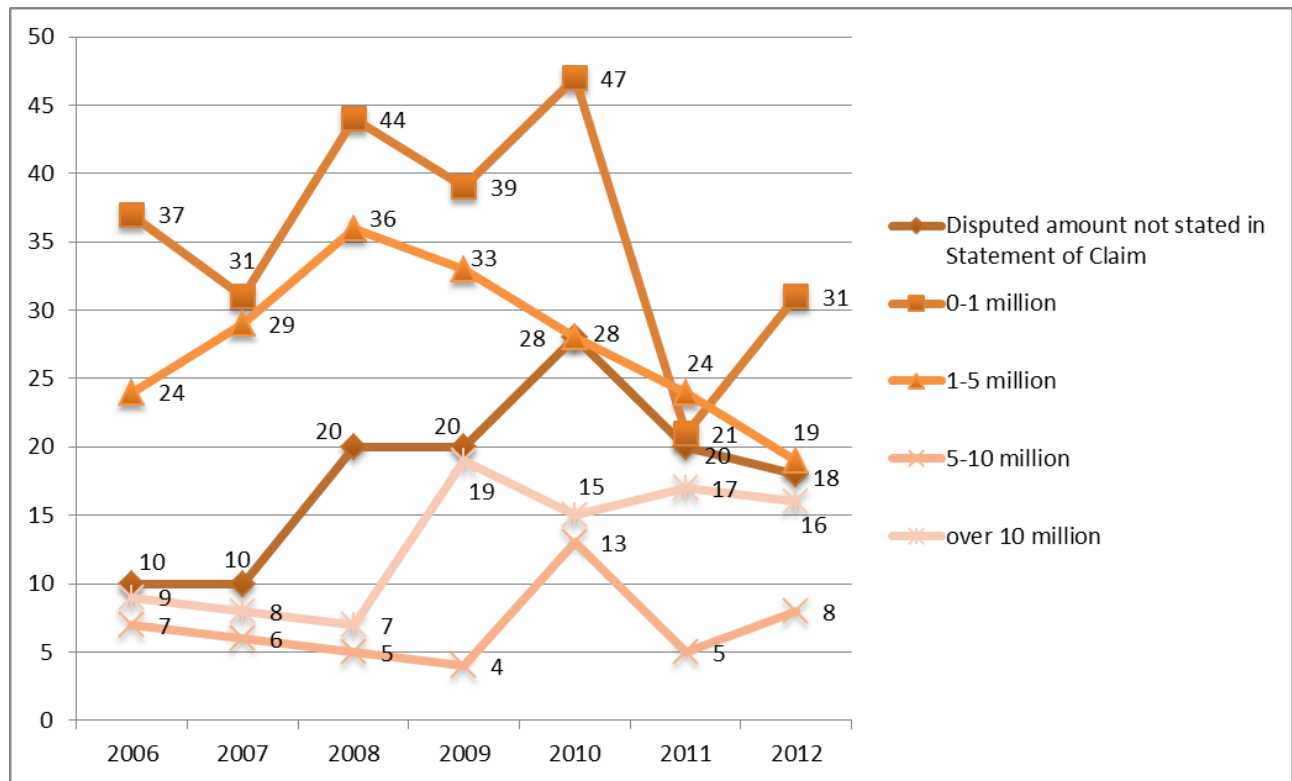


### Cases received in 2012 - distributed by type

Number of arbitrations categorized by the in disputed value of the case

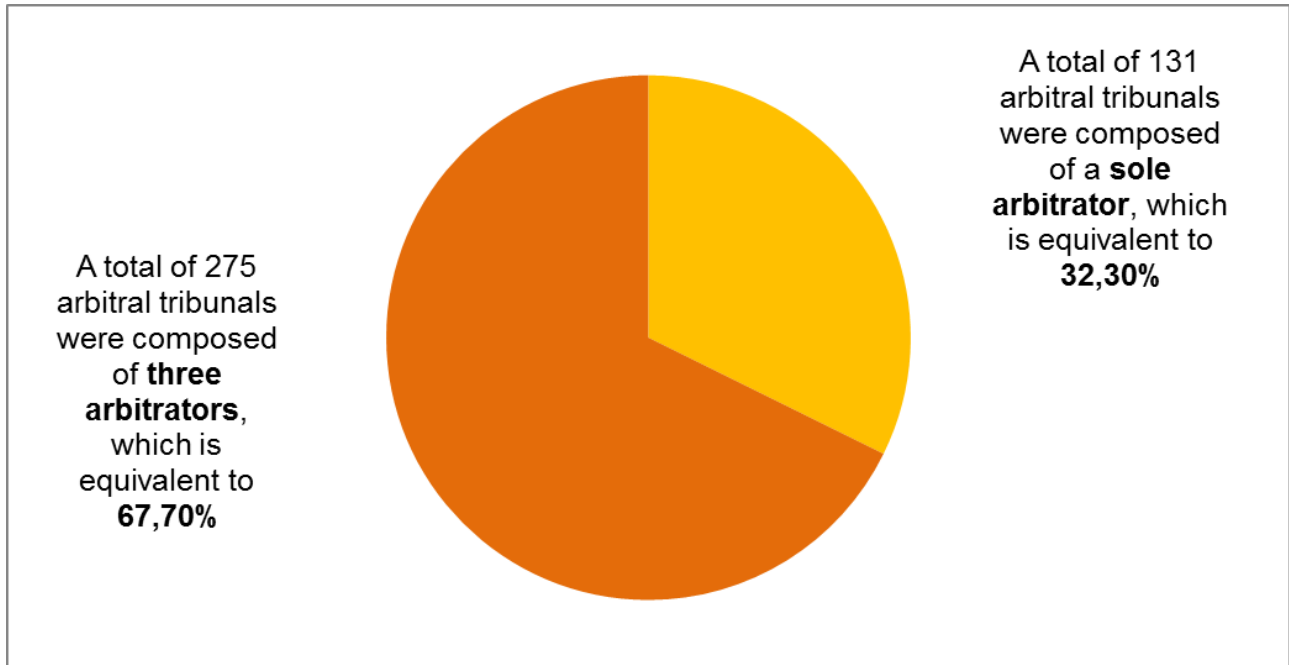


**Final awards**

In 2012 a total of 46 final awards were made, hereof 10 in international arbitration cases.

The average time of procedure for these cases is 1 year and 7 months in national arbitration cases, and 1 year and 8 months in international arbitration cases.
