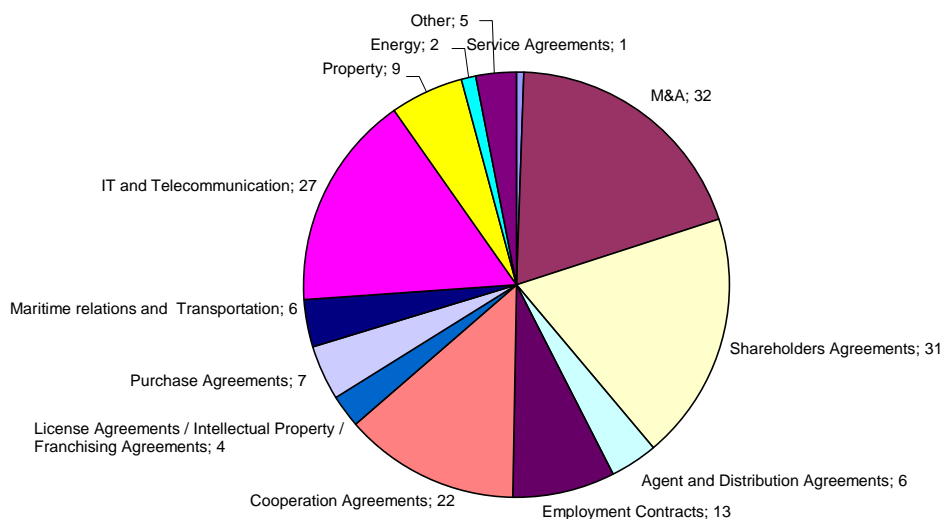


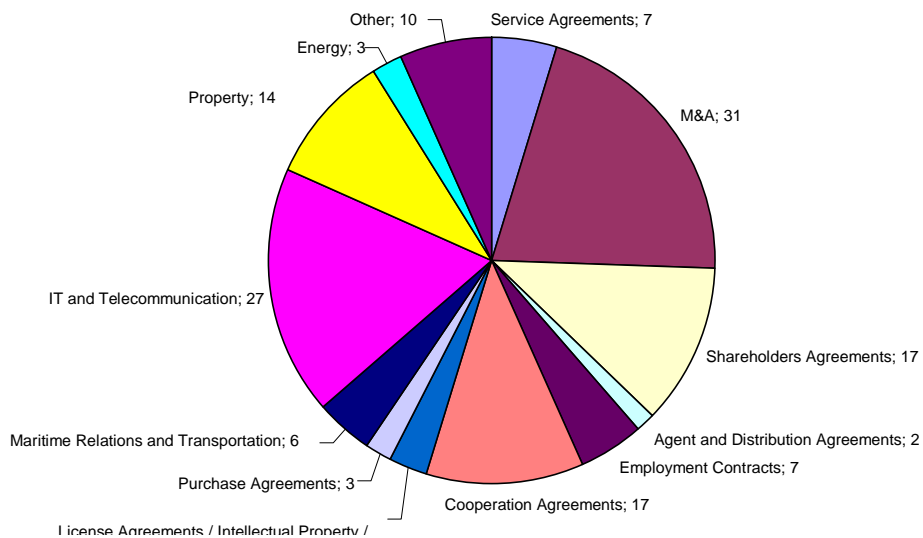
Statistical Report 2010

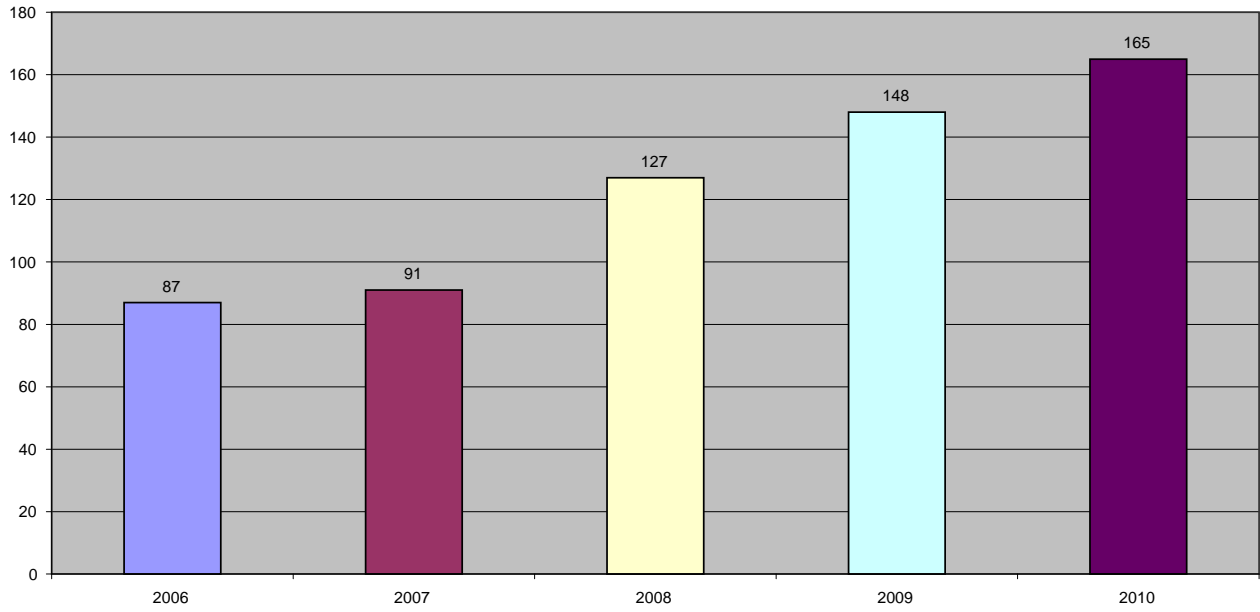
Cases in total, categorized - 2010



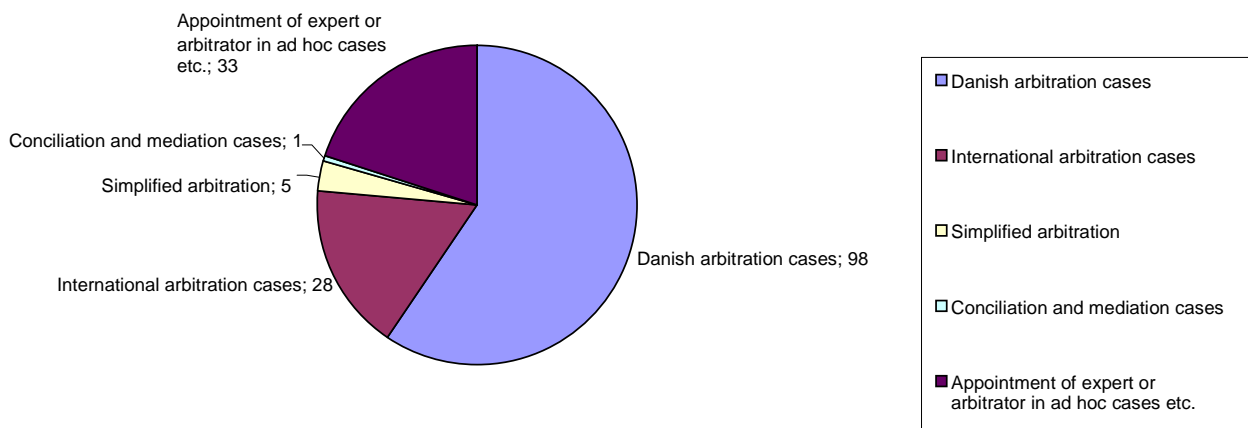
Cases in total, categorized - 2009



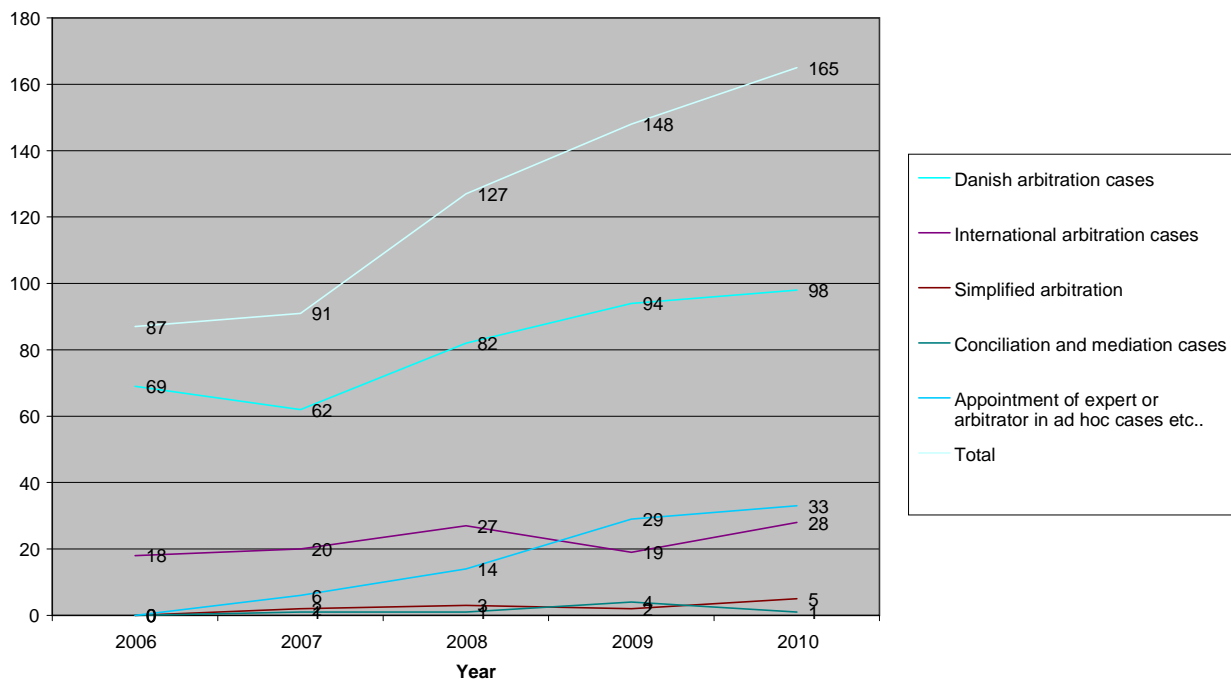
Number of cases initiated in the period of 2006-2010

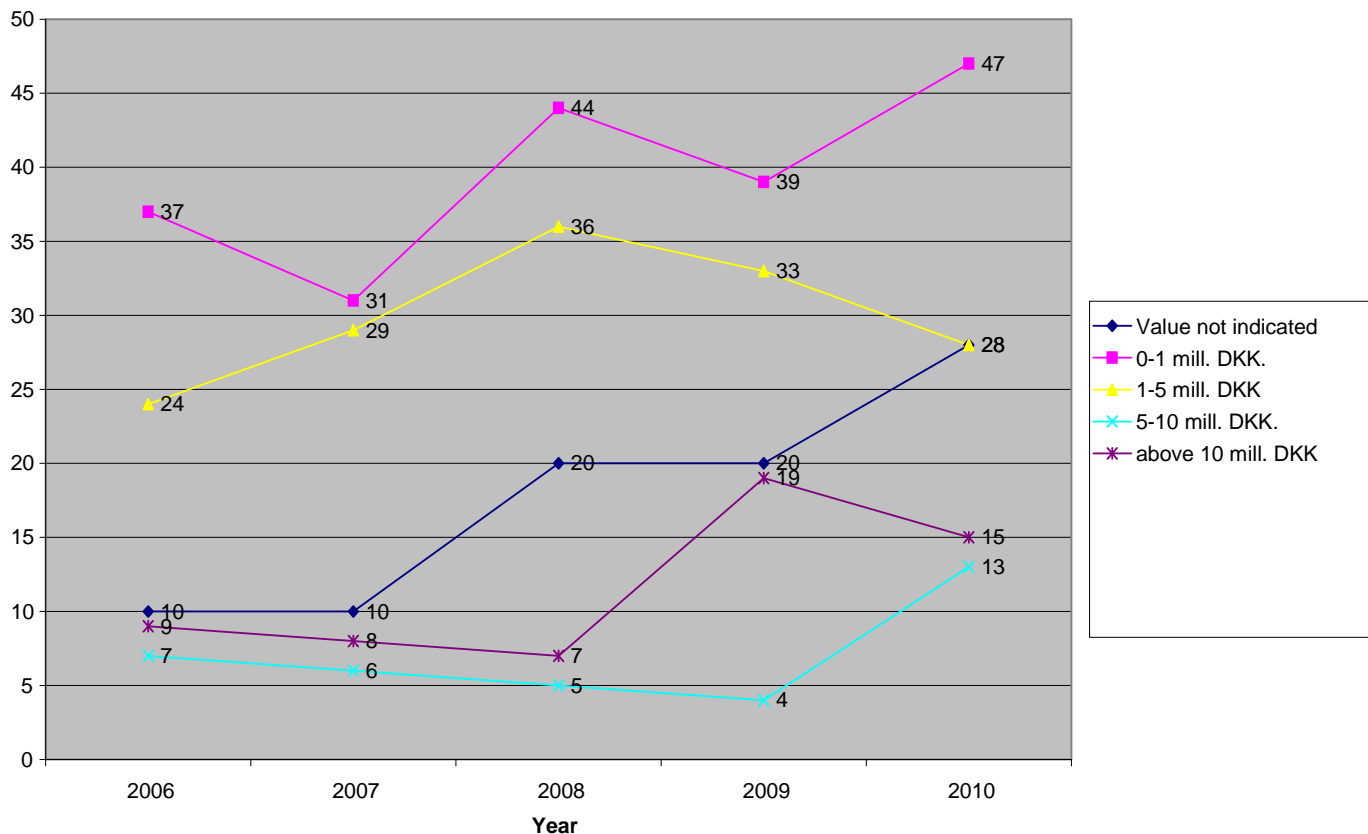

Awards and declarations

In 2010 40 awards were made, hereof 6 in international arbitration cases, and 15 declarations, all in Danish arbitration cases. The average time of procedure for these cases is 11 months in arbitration cases, and 1 year and 6 months in international arbitration cases. In 2009 41 awards and declarations were made, hereof 11 in international arbitration cases. The average time of procedure for the Danish arbitration cases is 1 year and 2 months, and 1 year and 7 months for the international arbitration cases.
