




An average of 117 cases per year has been filed at the Danish Institute of Arbitration (DIA) in the past five years.




SUBJECT-MATTERS OF DISPUTES FILED IN 2022




SECTORS OF DISPUTES FILED IN 2022




SOLE ARBITRATORS AND THREE-MEMBER TRIBUNALS IN 2022




PARTY-APPOINTED AND INSTITUTE-APPOINTED ARBITRATORS IN 2022

Nationality of the Parties

In the cases filed in 2022, the Parties came from 23 different nationalities (including Denmark).

Final Awards Rendered

In 2022, a total of 51 final awards on the merits were rendered.

Gender

In 2022, approximately 21% of all the arbitrator appointments at the DIA were female.
