




The Danish Institute of Arbitration's caseload


An average of 114 cases per year have been filed at the Danish Institute of Arbitration (DIA) in the past five years.





Subject matters of disputes filed in 2023




Sectors of disputes filed in 2023






SOLE ARBITRATORS AND THREE-MEMBER TRIBUNALS IN 2023

Nationality of the Parties

In the cases filed in 2023, the parties came from 26 different nationalities (including Denmark).

Countries

Australia, Austria, Bangladesh, China, Cyprus, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ghana, Greenland, Ireland, Italy, Kenya, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Marshall Islands, Netherlands, Portugal, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom and USA.

Final Awards Rendered

In 2023, a total of 50 final awards on the merits were rendered.

Gender Diversity

In 2023, approximately 23% of all the arbitrator appointments at the DIA were female.

Out of the arbitrators appointed by the parties, approximately 13% were female.

Out of the arbitrators appointed by the DIA, approximately 31% were female.

Out of all the appointed three-member tribunals, approximately 43% had a female chair.
