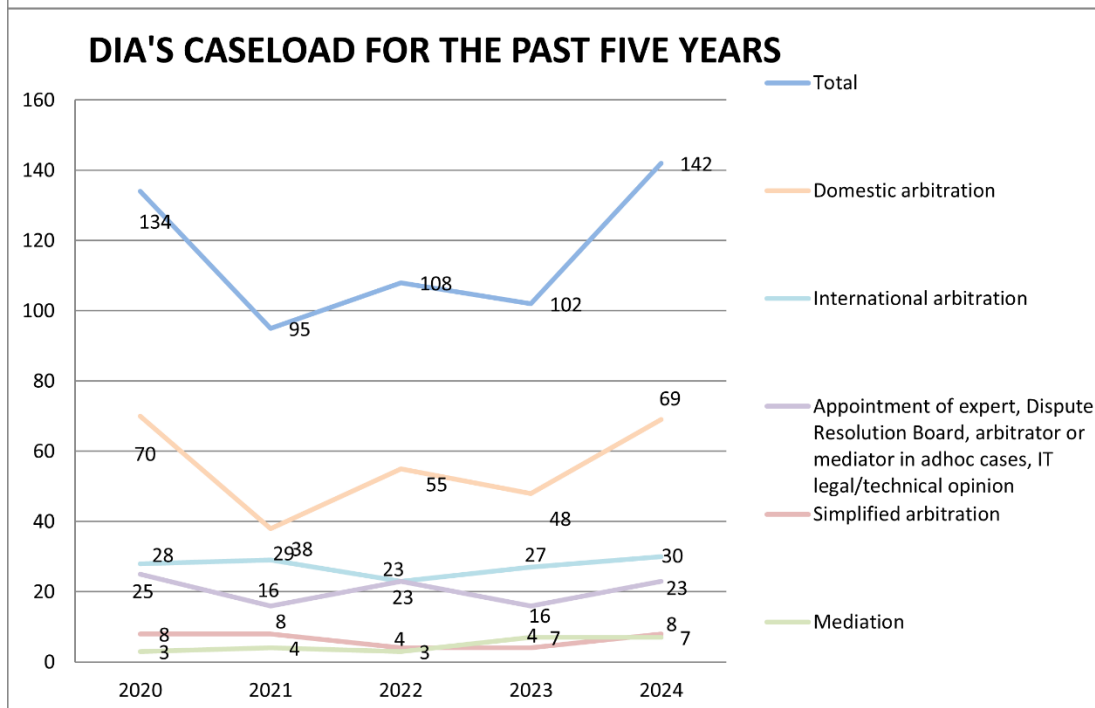
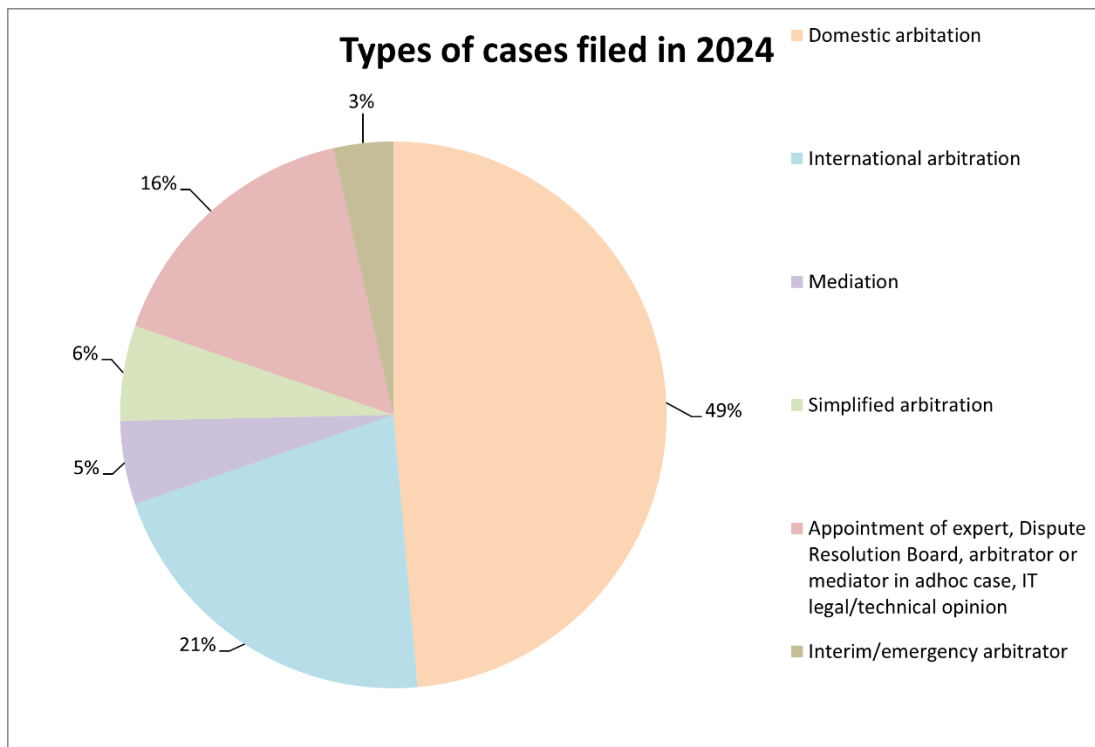


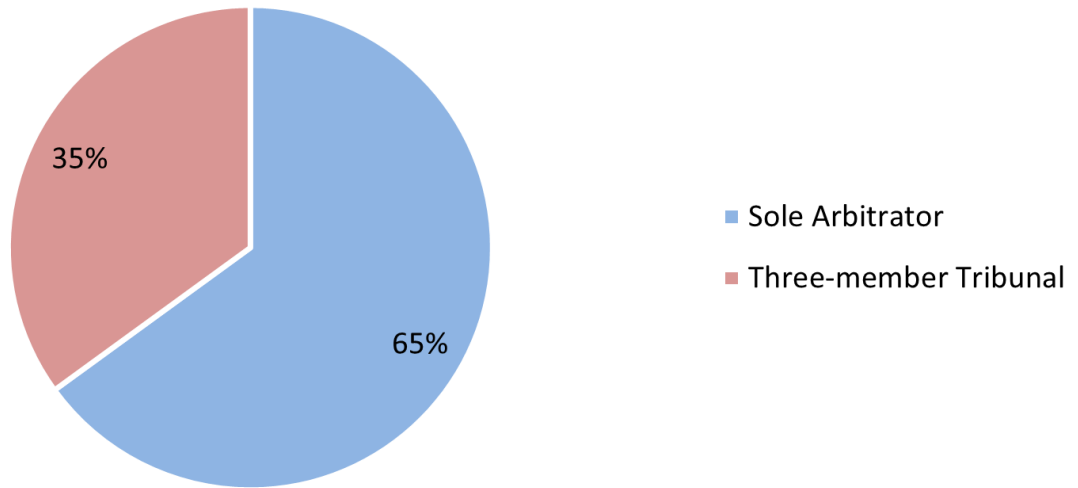

The Danish Institute of Arbitration's caseload

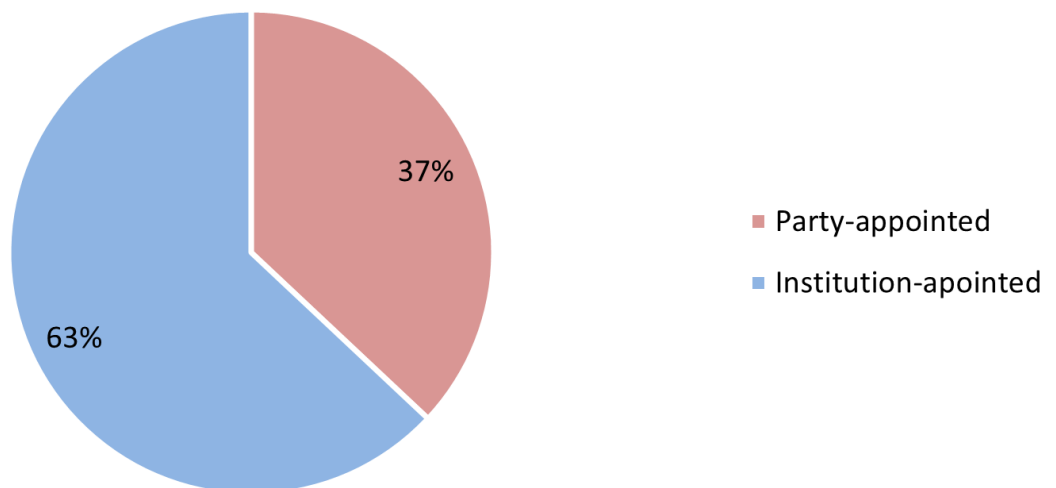
An average of 116 cases per year have been filed at the Danish Institute of Arbitration (DIA) in the past five years.



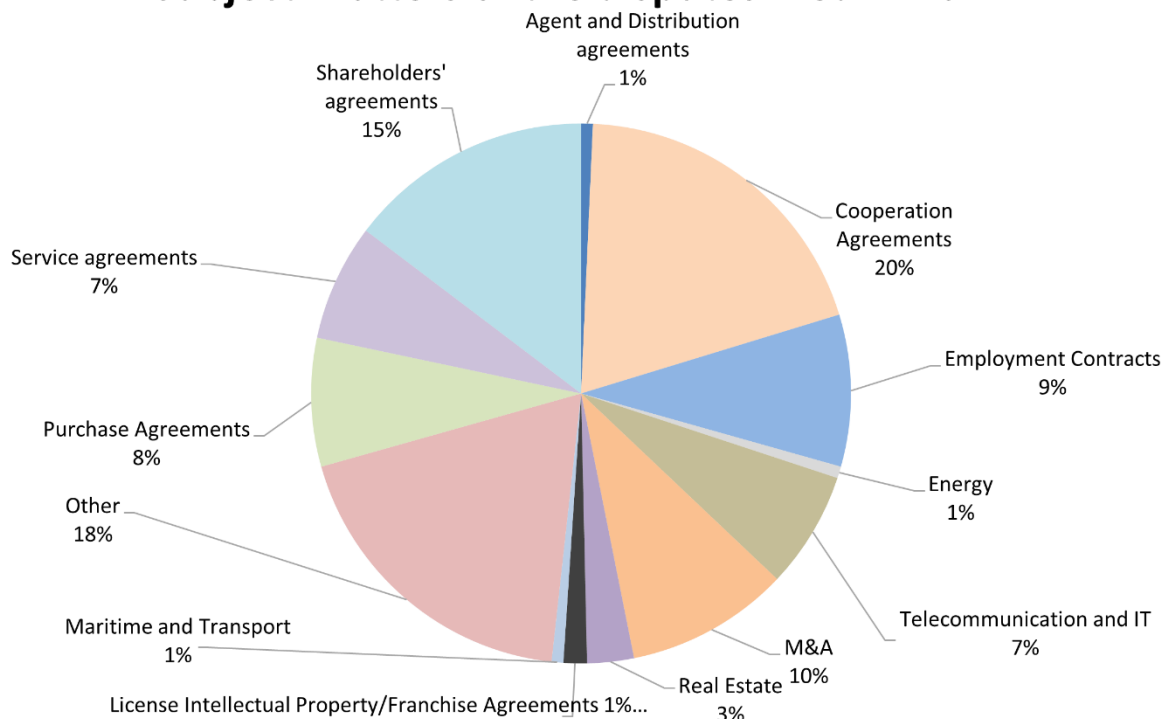
SOLE ARBITRATORS AND THREE-MEMBER TRIBUNALS IN 2024



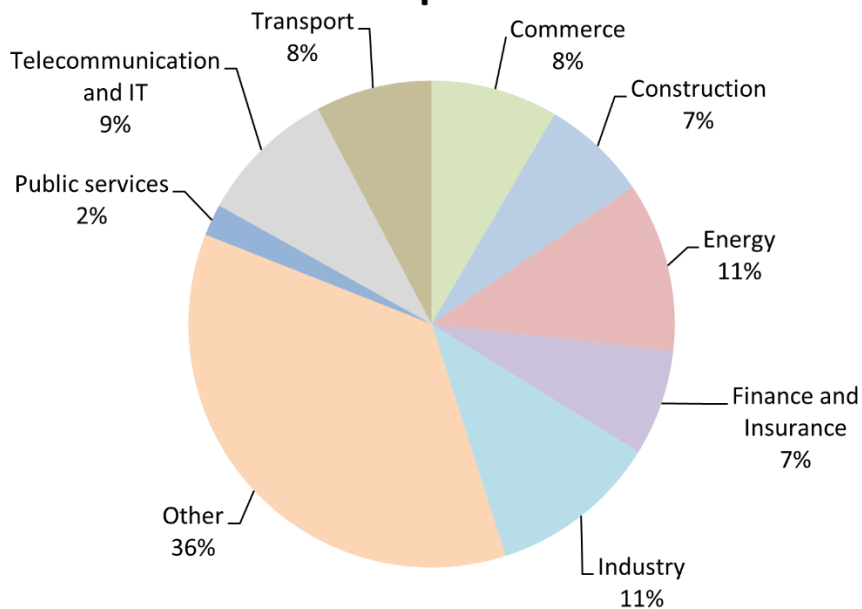
PARTY-APPOINTED AND INSTITUTION-APPOINTED ARBITRATORS IN 2024



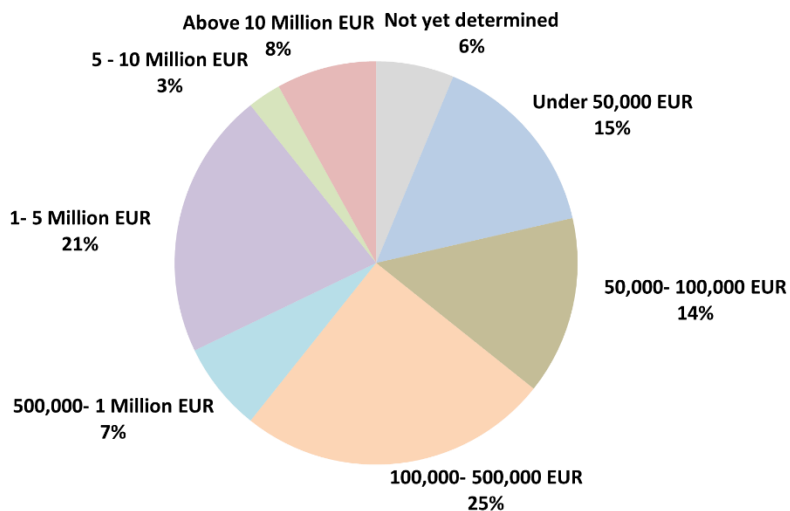
Subject-matters of the disputes filed in 2024



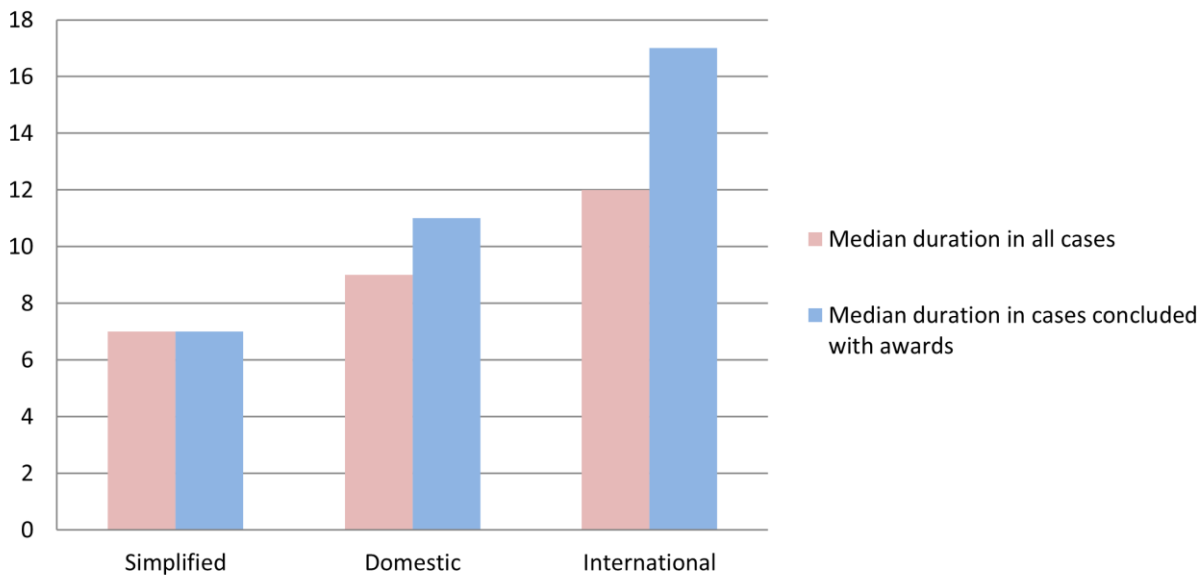
Sectors of the disputes filed in 2024

Nationality of the Parties

In the cases filed in 2024, the parties came from 23 different nationalities (including Denmark).

Final Awards Rendered

In 2024, a total of 34 final awards on the merits were rendered.

Gender Diversity

In 2024, approximately 20% of all the arbitrator appointments at the DIA were female.

Out of the arbitrators appointed by the parties, approximately 8% were female.

Out of the arbitrators appointed by the DIA, approximately 27% were female.

Out of all the appointed three-member tribunals, approximately 31% had a female chair.

The DIA notes that owing to the increased number of cases, the number of female arbitrator appointments increased in 2024 compared to 2023.
